Minutes of the meeting held at the Oliver Jones Memorial Hall on Wednesday 2nd April 2014

Previous minutes

The minutes of the last meeting – one error noted, a blocked drain was in Llwynmawr, not Dolywern.
Proposed by P Hughes, seconded by F Howell.

Report by PcSO R Holmes:

- Crime – no reports this month.
- Local police will have a marked vehicle within 12-18 months.
- PCSO Holmes will be working 12 hour shifts, 4pm – 4am.
- Unable to obtain grant towards cost of bridge repairs but has offered to bake cakes and visit local schools and shops to sell them to raise funds. A colleague in St Asaph has donated funding for cakes.
- Photos have been supplied of the bridge following the incident and showing no damage.
- Current priorities – Speeding and following up with 4x4s.

Report by County Councillor B Roberts

- A letter received from Dylan Roberts about road resurfacing in the Ceiriog Valley. More than half the roads listed are in the Glyntraian community.
- The hospital car is safe.
- Buses – Some level of service will be maintained but some routes will be lost, dependant on service tenders. There should be at least 3 or 4 journeys per day up the valley.

Matters arising

- Road repairs. Clerk now communicating with Dylan Jones who is directly in charge of road repairs.
- Pontfadog play area. Agreement regarding interim maintenance costs by WCBC signed.
- Four Councils' meeting. All 3 councils have responded and made suggestions.
- Milestone on Dolywern bridge. Clerk and Councillors Vyse and Howell met Sgt Burns to discuss and view photographs taken after the incident. No damage to bridge apparent. Possibility of PSCO applying for grant towards costs.
- Grass cutting. Adverts inviting tenders placed in newspaper and Glyn News.
- £500 granted towards provision of a website for GCC.
