Report by PC D Jenkins

- 2 Road Traffic Collisions last month.
- The successful operation to target 4x4 drivers and motorcyclists who are abusing the tracks and bridleways is to be repeated.
- Speed cameras will be in the area soon.
- PCSO Proudlove running Operation Cinnamon again in March.
- Priority: speed cameras.

Play Area and Equipment Report

- Clerk to seek estimates for new signage and contact dog warden re NO DOGS signs.
- The damaged fence at the rear of the Hall is the responsibility of WCBC and is due to be repaired very soon.
- Slabs around the Cenotaph in Pontfadog need shoring up and one needs replacing. Cllr Lawford to arrange.
- The stone bus shelter in Dolywern has a leaky roof and the backrest of the fixed seat needs fixing. Clerk to seek three quotes for repairs.
- Work to be left until spring/summer: Repainting equipment, fill gaps in roundabout and surrounding the safety surfaces.
